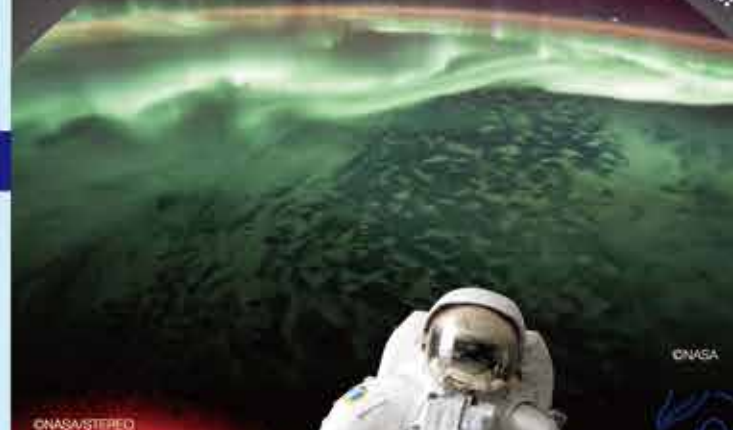

Planetarium Hall features a 26.5m diameter dome screen projecting real all-sky images, panorama of the heavens, breathtaking videos, and an invitation to the universe for all who attend.

At the Planetarium, staff experts present live descriptions of the constellations and other heavenly bodies visible that night as well as topics on themes about universe.

- Seating for 300 (open seating, full substitute system)
- Narration is in Japanese only. (There is no translation machine.)
- No entry during the show.

- Train
 - 500m west from the number 3 exit of Higobashi Station of the Yotsubashi Subway Line
 - 400m southwest from the number 2 exit of Watanabebashi Station of the Keihan Nakanoshima Line
 - 900m south from Hanshin Line, JR Osaka Loop Line Fukushima Station and JR Tozai Line Shin-Fukushima Station
- Bus
 - 300m southwest from the Taminobashi stop of city bus route 53
